

Lord of the Flies: Assessment

Think about the different groups in the novel Lord of the Flies:

- Jack's choir/hunters
- Littluns

Choose to be one of these characters and write a narrative piece based on the events to date in the novel, from this character's viewpoint.

In your narrative you will need to:

- Introduce the groups/characters
- Say how you have ended up on the island
- Talk about the main characters - Ralph, Piggy and Jack
- Describe the island setting
- Explain your job on the island as part of the group of boys
- Share your fears, hopes and feelings about what might happen

Use what you have read so far in the novel to help you, e.g. the Scar; the fire getting out of control; finding the conch; having rules; hunting for pig

1. **Plan** - Spend some time thinking and making notes on what you will write. Plan out your ideas and keep them for reference throughout your writing.

2. **Write** your narrative thinking about:

- Punctuation
- Paragraphs
- Sentence structure
- Vocabulary chosen
- Reference to events in the novel

DO NOT just retell the story in your own words. You must use evidence from the novel to help you tell your character's story.

3. **Proofread and edit** your finished piece making any corrections that you need to, before handing it in for marking.

** Pay particular attention to "How to progress" comments, made after the last assessment piece.
