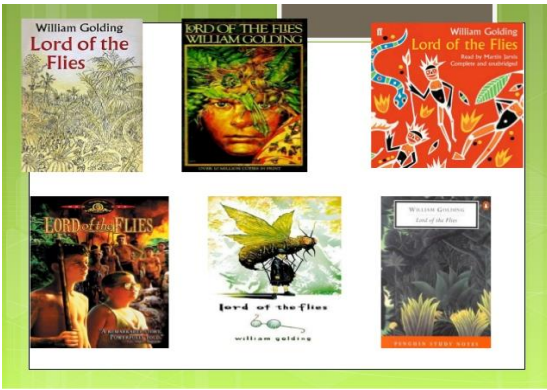


Questions for Lesson 3



Analyse:

1. How does Piggy feel about Ralph? Be sure to discuss his feelings early in the chapter, as well as towards the end.
2. Towards the end of the chapter the boys stumble upon a small pig tangled in vines. Jack draws his knife ''with a flourish'' but hesitates to stab the pig. Before he can commit to the deed, the pig wriggles free and disappears into the jungle. What does the scene with the pig reveal about Jack's character? What is the significance of the boys' encounter with the pig at the end of this chapter?
