
In light of your self-assessment, **re-draft your paragraph** based upon the strengths and areas to improve that you found. Have you implemented your improvements in order to get a higher level??


You are now to re-read your 2nd draft of the paragraph and assess it again. How well have you used your understanding to write about the characters in Stone Cold? (RAF3).
