1	<u>Lesson 1</u>	To complete a reading assessment based on an extract from Stone Cold.	<p>Give the students an extract from Robert Swindells' Stone Cold. The part of the novel describes the night that Link and Ginger spend on the canal boat owned by the man known to the homeless people as "Captain Hook."</p> <p>Explain to the students that they need to read the extract and answer the questions using quotations where necessary. 2	<u>Lesson 2</u>	To design a leaflet	<p>Students are to design a leaflet for a fictitious charity called HOMES4ALL.
